

Modified Yellow Level of Operation Addendum as of 4.5.21

After Spring Break on Monday, April 6, 2021, the following transitional activities will begin in one or more schools, depending on site-specific circumstances:

- **Elementary Level:** The elementary level spends the first month teaching routines. These routines are important to students to have structure and familiarity with what they can expect throughout the school day. With only two months of school left and ISAT Testing starting, to change routine at this time, significant time teaching to the new routines would need to be allocated. This would be very difficult for tier 2 and tier 3 behavior students. Schedules will essentially remain the same for students, while adding student activities previously restricted.
 - Revise end of year assemblies based on capacity restrictions
 - Revise recess plans to lift zone restrictions to increase social interaction
 - Parent volunteer opportunities increased
 - Loosen flex group (mixed cohorts) restrictions and mentoring opportunities
 - Update classroom seating arrangements, as appropriate
- **Middle Level:**
 - Students will transition back to eating in the lunchroom
 - End of year celebration will occur in person
 - Update desk configurations as needed - bring tables back into classrooms slowly to accommodate labs
 - Incoming 6th grade orientation will occur in person
- **High School Level:**
 - Current bell schedule will be maintained; changing all high school student schedules for Quarter 4 would be extremely disruptive
 - End of year assemblies and prom will be in person
 - Graduation ceremonies will be in person, while abiding with restrictions at site
 - All spring sports will continue as normally scheduled
 - Continue to allow parents to transport their students to events if requested
 - Prom, mock DUI car crash, 8th grade orientation, and the scholarship ceremony will be in person
 - ASB elections will be virtual, but class elections will include a grade level assembly in person
 - Band and Choir classes will move back into the assigned classroom
